

- Gloves and protective eyewear (recommended)




STEP-BY-STEP ASSEMBLY

Step 1: Side and Base Assembly

• Attach side panels to the base using 1/4" x 1/2" hex bolts and flange nuts (x8 total).


Assembly Tip


Do not fully tighten bolts until egg box lid is installed. Use flange nuts for all 1/4" bolts unless otherwise noted. All bolts: 1/4" x 1/2" unless stated otherwise.



Step 1: Side and Base Assembly


• Use the rear holes if configuring for reverse (back) entrance.






Step 2: Install Roost Support

- Position roost support between sides as shown.
- Secure with 1/4" x 1/2" bolts and flange nuts (x4).




Step 3: Attach Back Bottom Panel

- Align panel to back side of base.
- Fasten using wood grip screws #8 x 1/2" (x4).
- If building back entrance version, install lid support screws into this panel.




Step 4: Install Egg Box Lid

- Insert hinge tabs of the egg box lid into side panel slots.
- Secure using 1/4" x 1/2" bolts and flange nuts (x2).
- Tighten all bolts only after lid is fully aligned.




Step 5: Install Lid Support & Curtain

• Attach lid support and curtain using sheet metal screws #8 (x3).




Step 6: Top Cover and Mounting Bracket

- Position top cover over the entire assembly.
- Secure with 1/4" x 1/2" bolts and flange nuts (x6).
- Attach mounting bracket as needed (x4 bolts).




Optional: Back Entrance Configuration

- To convert to a back entrance, flip the entire top box and move roost support to the rear.
- Reuse side holes as needed for entrance opening.
- Back entrance configuration also requires removing 5 bolts on both sides to rotate.



Back entrance configuration also requires you to move roost assembly to back side.

To flip entrance to the back side take out 5 bolts on both sides, and flip entire box.
